*Notice is hereby given to the general public that the Weights and Measures Services Division will hold a workshop open to the public to solicit feedback regarding Arizona Administrative Code Title 3, Chapter 7, Article 7, as it pertains to the Cleaner-Burning Gasoline (CBG) program. The CBG program was implemented 20 years ago to protect air quality. Since that time, gasoline composition and federal requirements have changed significantly. The purpose of this workshop is to review the current status of air quality in the CBG-covered area and the State of Arizona along with the requirements of the federal and CBG programs. There will be an open discussion to solicit feedback regarding potential streamlining efforts that may be pursued to reduce the regulatory burden and alleviate constraints that may impact fuel supplies and the citizens of Arizona, while continuing to provide necessary air quality protections.
