The Arizona Department of Weights and Measures (ADWM), in coordination with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), Maricopa County Air Quality Division (MCAQD), and the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG), will hold a stakeholder meeting to discuss administrative planning and action related to the Arizona Stage II Vapor Recovery Program.

At the stakeholder meeting, there will be an update on the preparation of the State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision for the removal of the Stage II Vapor Recovery equipment in the Maricopa Ozone Planning Area. Additionally there will be an update regarding decommissioning timeframes and the anticipated legislation regarding Stage II vapor recovery.
