The Department of Weights and Measures is issuing this *Vapor Recovery Alert* to inform the Registered Service Agency (RSA), community of several new items that have been placed on the Department's website at

- Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) 305, titled "Vapor Recovery Annual Test for Vacuum and Balance Systems" has been revised. This SOP replaces previously issued SOP 305 and SOP 306.
- The forms required during annual testing of a vapor recovery system. Please use these forms when conducting future vapor recovery testing. Several of the forms have a place to put your company information at the top of the form.
Please be aware that the pre-test checklist is now required to be turned in for all annual tests conducted, regardless of whether or not a pre-test was conducted. RSRs were informed of this requirement during the training conducted in April 2013.

Also, the department has also implemented a new program to approve equipment certified by a third party. The program requirements and a listing of approved equipment can be found on the website at:
